



## WESTERN / NUWARA ELIYA REGIONS





## UVA/UDAPUSSELLAWA REGIONS




Both regions reported sunny weather and occasional showers throughout the week. According to the Department of Meteorology, rain is expected in the Uva Region in the week ahead.
